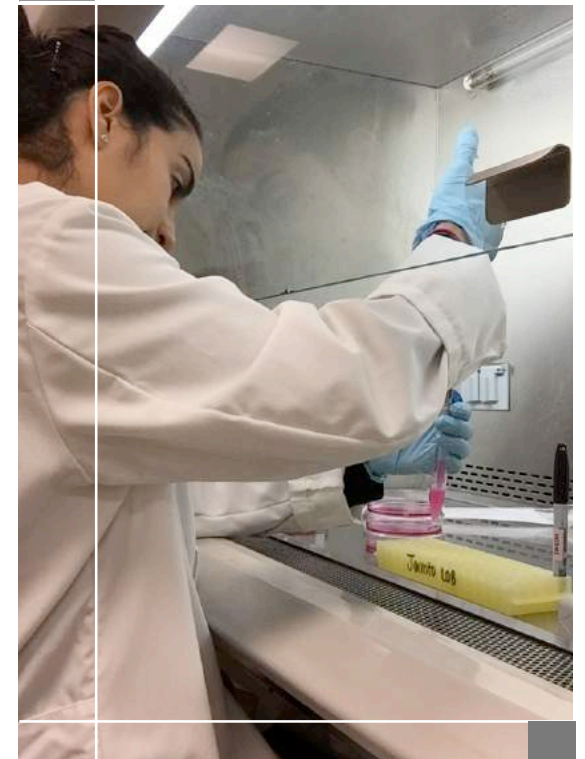

A RUP-IMSD Program

Summer Research Program at Rutgers May 30 – Aug 2 2017

Participating students will:

- Work on a research project with a Rutgers research mentor matched to the student's interest.
- Receive a \$3,000 stipend for the 10-weeks summer program at Rutgers (housing not included).
- Attend weekly professional development activities.
- Learn how to prepare and deliver a scientific talk.
- Prepare and present a poster at a research symposium at Rutgers.
- Have an opportunity to continue doing research during the academic year.



Eligibility

- Must be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident.
- Preference given to applicants from the following underrepresented groups: African American, Hispanic American, American Indian or natives of US Pacific Islands; and students with disabilities.
- GPA must be 3.0 or higher, with at least 3 semesters of college successfully completed. Rising juniors are preferred, but all qualifying students are welcome to apply.
- Participants must commit full-time to the program for the 10 weeks.
