### SASHP Requirements Review Form

To graduate as an SAS Honors Scholar, an SASHP student must:

- Complete, with a passing grade, a minimum of one Honors Colloquium. A second Honors Colloquium or an alternative chosen from the following: 1) taking a Byrne Seminar 2) serving as a Peer Instructor for a FIGS course 3) taking an Honors section of an SAS Signature Course (when offered) 4) studying abroad on a program for which a student receives Rutgers credit
- Complete, with a grade of a C or better, a minimum of 4 courses totaling 12 or more credits that are designated as Honors Seminars or Department-Based Honors Courses. Please note: this requirement cannot be satisfied with research credits or be used to also fulfill the capstone requirement.
- Demonstrate proficiency in a foreign language through the intermediate level.
- Satisfactorily complete a Capstone Project of at least 6 credits (3 credits per semester).
